### INTRODUCTION

Owned by the Tshwane City Council, Uitsig Squash Club leases and operates the facility.

Established in 1990, we are a community league affiliated club and as such, a non-profit organisation. All income is used to operate and maintain the club!

An elected committee of volunteers dedicate their free time, without remuneration, to operate the club on behalf of the members. The club administrator and operational staff are remunerated according to the work outputs.

It is important to understand, that all members of the Uitsig Squash Club, are part of a syndicate, who are collectively responsible to ensure the continued existence of the Club.

We are conveniently located at the corner of Panorama and Knoet road in Rooihuiskraal, a thriving suburb within Centurion.

### FACILITIES

The facilities are available for use by members between 05h30 – 23h00 every day of the year. There are some restrictions and limitations on court usage. See Membership Section.

#### Courts

We have four single squash courts, of which two have glass backs. There are ample viewing areas, from the ground and first floor gallery.

The court reservation, utilisation and billing process is all controlled by the court management system

#### Change Rooms

We have spacious ladies and gents change rooms with 3 showers and several toilets. They are equipped with large geysers, so hot water on those cold winter nights, is always available.

#### Kiosk

Our Kiosk stocks essential items such as sports drinks for those energy sapping encounters, and of course a selection of ales, ciders and coolers for your enjoyment after a deserving game.

The kiosk also stocks a range of sports equipment and accessories for ease of convenience and exceptional value, below retail price.

The kiosk operates every Monday to Thursday 16h30 – 20h30 and on league and tournament days.

#### Entertainment Areas

There is a generous entertainment area adjacent to Court 1 which includes a built in braai.

We also have a secure outside enclosed braai and entertainment area as well as a grassed play park to keep children occupied and a dedicated smoking area.

### PROMOTING THE GAME

We are a league playing club under the auspices of the Northern Squash Association.

We have a close alliance with Centurion Junior Squash which is a perfect platform to introduce school children to the game.

We also run an Uitsig Squash Academy for members that want that extra guidance from our resident club coach and top 1<sup>st</sup> league players.

Several tournaments and events keep Uitsig Squash members active.

We are well known for our Summer League (November) and Strawberry Pot Doubles Tournament (1<sup>st</sup> week of December).

### MEMBERSHIP
