I would like to take this opportunity to thank the team captains, Audette Smith and Maryna Fourie for doing a sterling job this league season. Reserve League: Captained by Sharon Cousins

This team has grown from strength to strength over the last couple of years. From ending 2nd last in 2013 and 7th in 2014 to ending 4th in 2015. We have not only improved our positioning but also the amount of points scored from 71 in 2013, 138 in 2014 to 183 in 2015. The ultimate goal would be to have a first league side representing Uitsig Squash in 2016.

2B League: Captained by Audette Smith

Thank you to Audette after taking over the reins of the team. Being new in the squash environment and with a few new comers the team did remarkably well ending 4th overall after ending 6th last year. Points improved from 151 in 2014 to 153 in 2015.
