2 Conditions of Return to Play

All conditions as laid out in the **Return to Play, Operational Plan v1.2**, must be strictly adhered to, as described in the above document ([Link to approved Return to Play Plan](#)).

Additional conditions have been instituted by the Minister which must at all times be enforced. The Department may, without notice, deploying officials to monitor the terms of play. Such officials are authorised and can be identified using specific Identification Document, from the department:

- All clubs are complaint with the above operational plan
- Controlled access to the facilities (numbers), to be enforced

- Persons displaying high temperatures/ high-risk contact or travel history, must NOT be allowed entrance
- All persons entering the venue must wear a mask
- Training venues to be disinfected daily
- Access control measures to the club (screening and attendance/ tracing registers at all times)
- Health Official to be present on site
- No spectators (with the exception of guardians for minors)
- All areas declared a Hotspot under the Disaster Management Act, 20023 (Act No 57 of 2002), and its subsequent amendments should be avoided subject to the advisory from the Department of Health. Extra precautionary measures must be put in place if allowed to train in these areas (and will be provided by the above department).

Failure to adhere to these criteria, not only places the sports' authorised return-to-play and our outgoing National teams in jeopardy, but may result in sanction from Squash South Africa, your Provincial Federation and/or any actions permitted under the Disaster Management Act, 20023 (Act No 57 of 2002), and its amendments.

2.1 Authorised Player/ Coaches

Only approved persons may partake, during the various phases of re-opening.

- A list of approved coaches, is maintained on the Squash SA website; and
- A list of approved players, is maintained on the Squash SA website

2.2 Authorised Activities

Play may not take place at a venue, that has not been authorised in writing by Squash SA.
